

Fruitland City Council Meeting at City Hall

Tuesday, October 12th, 2021

7:00 pm – Council meeting

Roll Call – Present were Anderson, Bowers, Hills, Hillman and Garrett. Painter was absent.

Minutes of Last Meeting – Garrett made a motion to approve the minutes of the last meeting and Bowers 2nd.

Motion passed unanimously.

Approve Agenda – Bowers made a motion to approve agenda and Garrett 2nd. Motion passed unanimously.

Financial Report – Garrett made a motion to approve the financial report and Bowers 2nd. Motion passed unanimously. Fund balances are as follows: Road - \$43,330.23 LOST Sewer & Water - \$60,153.67 LOST Lawful - \$216,921.27.

Old Business

Nuisance Abatement – Clerk Shoppa gave an update on the property at 161 Sand Run Road. Mr. Dingbaum advised a search warrant was issued on October 6th, 2021 and approximately 40 vehicles were photographed and recorded. The resident has thirty days to comply with the prohibited acts charge or they will file charges. The other resident at 116 Evergreen Lane has mowed their yard per our request at the last meeting.

Annual Financial Report – Clerk Shoppa advised that the report was sent to the paper on September 27, 2021 and published on October 6th, 2021.

EMA & 911 Meetings – Garrett has volunteered to replace Anderson on these committees. Clerks will find out if the Mayor has to advise or how that will be handled.

Driveway Compliance – Garrett made a motion to send letters by certified mail with a deadline of one year from letter as previously done to the two residents in violation. Anderson 2nd and the motion passed unanimously.

Community Center Table & Chairs – Clerks advised that Phelps Cleaning Service has picked up 10 chairs to be cleaned so the City Council can approve a bid to clean all community center chairs at the next meeting.

New Business

Fruitland Fun Day Financials/Square Point of Sale – Clerk Shoppa provided financials of the event. Garrett made a motion to set up an account with Square to accept debit cards next year. Bowers 2nd and motion passed unanimously.

Street Financial Report – Clerks provided street financial report to City Council members and advised this report is due December 1st, 2021.

Web Cam – Clerks advised City Council that we have received Web Cams for anyone that would like to sign one out.

Correspondence – Clerk Shoppa advised a resident stopped to file a complaint about a nuisance at 104 Sunrise Dr.
