

Fruitland City Council Meeting at City Hall

Tuesday, November 9th, 2021

7:00 pm – Council meeting

Roll Call – Present were Anderson, Hills, Painter, Hillman and Garrett. Bowers was absent.

Minutes of Last Meeting – Garrett made a motion to approve minutes of last meeting and Hillman 2nd. Motion passed unanimously.

Approve Agenda – Painter made a motion to approve agenda and Garrett 2nd. Motion passed unanimously.

Financial Report – Anderson made a motion to approve financial report and Painter 2nd. Motion passed unanimously. Fund balances are as follows: Road - \$49,840.09 LOST Sewer & Water - \$60,153.67 LOST Lawful - \$191,880.98.

Old Business

Placement of New Semi Signs – Garrett made a motion to replace old signs at all Fruitland city limits that reference 10 ton embargo ahead and old ordinance number and replace with new “no semi” signs except local deliveries. Anderson 2nd and motion was passed unanimously.

Nuisance Abatement – Clerks advised that Mr. Dingbaum reported that twenty four cars have been removed from the residence at 161 Sand Run Road and they will continue to keep us updated. City Council would like to know if there is a limit to number of cars taken per day/month to junk yards.

Community Center Tables and Chairs – Garrett made a motion to clean as many chairs that need it and Anderson 2nd. Motion passed unanimously. Painter will contact VH Willis to see if they can help with the tables.

New Business

Website/E-mail – Clerks advised new website was up and running and that we will continue with our current emails until term ends and then check into Yahoo if still necessary.

Security Camera at Drake Park – Anderson would like to check into new cameras at Drake Park to point towards the restrooms. Clerks will get two quotes to install new wireless cameras at Drake Park and the Community Center.

Television at Community Center – Anderson would like to see a bigger television installed at the Community Center for parties that rent this area. Anderson will check into prices and table until next meeting.

Ending Balance Discussion – City Council would like to see an audit done to confirm the ending balance difference after switching from QuickBooks to ClerkBooks. City Clerks will get two quotes to perform an audit.

Correspondence – Clerk Shoppa advised Fruitland Lions club will postpone Veterans Memorial Dedication until next spring.
