OLD BUSINESS:

Bingo Changes:

Board members agreed to hold off on changing the number of games played til next Fall. However, we will be changing the payouts on specials immediately. We also reviewed the financials and would like to see the income from all bingo card sales separated from the expenses to better understand what and where we may be losing money. We also would like to know the breakdown of cost by bingo item to determine if we are charging enough to cover costs.

We discussed changing entry fee to \$40 instead of \$50 and that we wanted March 29th @ 6 – 8pm here at the community center. Shelley was going to confirm date and entry fee with Jim.

City Council Meeting:

Megan is attending tomorrow night's city council meeting (2/8) to request a response to whether the city will match any fundraising funds for the shelter project. Mindy was going to try to attend as well.

Easter Event-April 9th:

April 9th has been scheduled for the egg hunt. We are asking Bingo attendees in Feb and March to bring in a bag of wrapped candy as a donation for Easter hunt. Those bringing a bag will receive a free special to play at Bingo that night. Limited to 2 specials per night. Mindy has already started promoting this on Facebook.

Instead of bicycles for prizes, we discussed giving baskets of candy/games to each of the 4 age groups at the egg hunt. (4) in total for roughly a total of \$100 in costs. Mindy and Megan's mothers will be asked to help shop for the basket

prize items. We may solicit help from Bickford and SunnyBrook again this year to help fill the eggs with candy. We will also fill eggs after Feb/Mar Bingo with the candy we have received as donations.

Each board member will bring 2 dozen cookies for the Easter event. Juice and hot chocolate will be served for participants and families.
